Charity and corporate challenges will test and develop resilience, teamwork, and adaptability in appropriately remote and demanding environments.

Long distance driving – Extended routes for charity challenges, requiring focus and endurance

Unpredictable conditions – weather, roads, wildlife, and delays mean nature sets the pace

Navigation and decision making – reading the land, using maps, SAT NAV, local knowledge, and trusting leaders

Cooking together – self catered meals, shared responsibility, and making the most of vehicle based kitchens

Daily camp routines – setting up and packing up camp together, building discipline, rhythm, and teamwork

Shared responsibility – looking after vehicles, equipment, and each other throughout the journey

Wildlife encounters – awareness of animal comfort zones and adjusting our behaviour accordingly

Group and social dynamics – living closely together, communicating well, and supporting different personalities

Time away from home – disconnecting from routines, comforts, and regular contact with family and friends

Mental resilience – managing tiredness and low moments, and finding strength in the group

Perspective and reflection – encountering poverty, threatened species awareness, gaining gratitude and a wider worldview

Simple expedition living – fewer comforts, adapting to a slower, and simpler routine, basic washing facilities

Rooftop and ground tents – exposed to the elements, personal space is more limited than usual

ROOF TOP TENTS & GROUND TENTS

- Roof top tents are designed for two people
- Ground tents can be provided if required
- All bedding is provided: mattress, sleeping bag, pillow, blankets



QUESTIONS & WHAT IF'S

Where and when do we buy our food etc?

We buy all the food and resupply at specific locations as we go. Discussed during prep session prior to departure.

What if a vehicle breaks down?

If a vehicle cannot continue, a replacement vehicle is arranged and the group remains together.

What if a leader becomes ill or injured?

We always travel with two leaders. If one is unwell, the trip continues safely. Both Haley & Angus have replacement leaders should they fall ill prior to the trip.

What if a participant becomes ill or injured?

Emergency Medical Assistance in place. Personal Medical Insurance required. Local medical facilities are known.

What if we get a puncture?

Vehicles carry spares, compressors, and changes are completed safely.

What if someone gets separated?

We operate strict convoy procedures and no one moves independently. All locations are pre-loaded on GPS.



QUESTIONS & WHAT IF'S

What if there's an emergency in a remote area?

Vehicles are fitted with trackers, and our movements are monitored. GPS coordinates for every location, reliable and emergency communications are in place.

What if our route, logistics, or timings are interrupted?

'Wriggle Room' is factored in: Wildlife Sightings / Wildlife At Camp / Weather / Photography / Rest stops / Punctures

Is it 'Follow The Leader' on all the driving days?

No, the lead vehicle changes every drive. Each vehicle has the chance to lead. There are specific reasons why Angus & Haley may take the lead in certain areas: Wildlife/ Bridge crossings etc

Do we go into a malaria area? What vaccination do we need?

We enter malaria areas on many of our trips. You must consult your Travel Nurse or GP.
